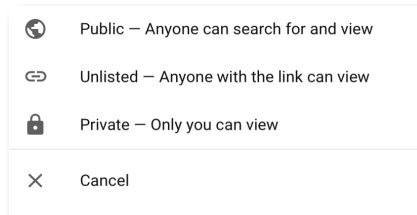


Mobile Videomaking

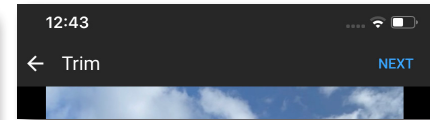
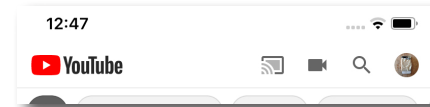
Uploading to Youtube, Vimeo, Canvas Media Gallery

Download the Youtube app from the ios appstore (ios 11.0) or Google Play store. Once open, click the small camera icon along the top bar of the app. Select your clip, trim, or edit it, then click Next.

Open the dropdown which shows Public. To send your project for private viewing, select unlisted instead.

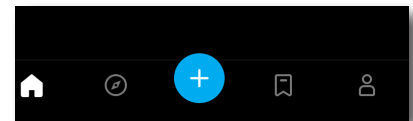


Send the link to whomever will be viewing your work.

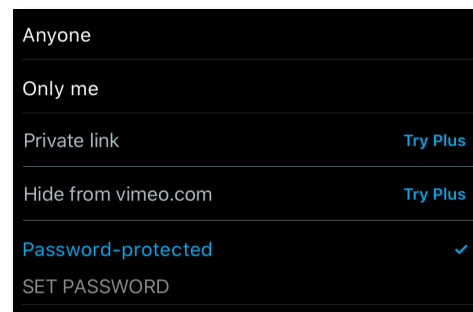
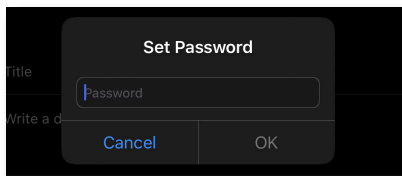


Add a name and description then click Upload.

Download the Vimeo app from the ios appstore (ios 12.4) or from the Google Play store. Along the bottom of the app there is a large +. Click this + and select your video. Either trim or hit Skip. Give your video a name and description.



Making a private link for your video is reserved for Plus accounts, but you can make your video password protected. Select Password-protected. Type in a password.



Download the Canvas Student app. (ios 12.0)

After logging in, you will arrive on your dashboard. Enter the course page. Scroll down to find Course Media Gallery. Click the + button to add media. Under the Add New dropdown, select Media Upload. Press + Choose File, locate your video in the photo library of your device. Trim or skip by pressing Choose. Your video will be compressed, then you will be asked to fill out its Name and Description. Make sure to use the naming conventions required for your coursework. Press Save. Your video will appear in the Course Media Gallery.
