Painting/Coloring

Open your document and create a new blank layer (video layer for animation) underneath the layer containing your artwork. Locate your layers in the “layers panel, which can be found under “Window>Layers.” Select your artwork layer. Click the layer mode labeled “Normal” and from the drop down menu select “Multiply.” Multiply changes all of the white pixels in your layer to transparent pixels, allowing you to draw on the layer underneath without altering your original artwork. This is especially effective with black line work. You will also avoid the fuzzy edges common when painting on the same layer.
