


and in the window that opens name your project, and using the *Where:* pulldown menu navigate to a place where you will save it, such as a folder on the desktop or the local server.

The Composition Name is not the project name, just the name of your composition - similar to a sequence in Premiere

- Preset: HD 1920x1080 24 fps
- Width: 1920 px
- Height: 1080 px

and check that the Lock Aspect Ratio to 16:9 box is checked

- Pixel Aspect Ratio: Square Pixels
- Frame Rate: 24 frames per second
- Resolution: Full
- Start Timecode: 0.00.00.00
- Duration: however long your timeline needsto be; 30 seconds is a good starting place
- Background Color: Black
