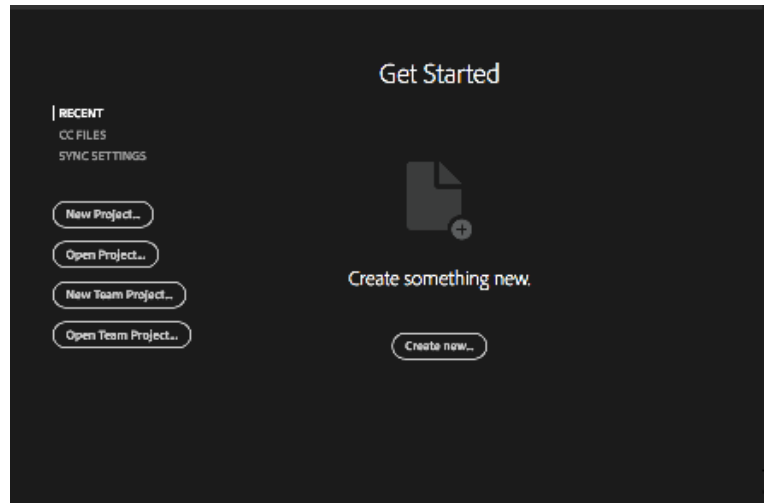
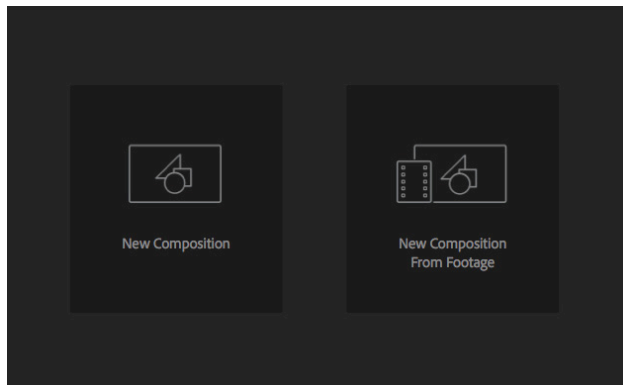


Setting up your After Effects Project

When After Effects launches you will see this this “Start” window.

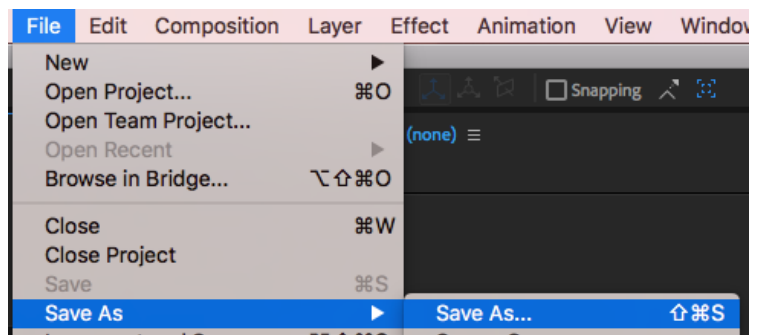
If you click “New Project” or “Create New” you’ll have two options...



“New Composition” or “New Composition from Footage”

To set your Project in good order, you should give it a name and location. Go to “File > Save As> Save As...”

Select “New Composition”



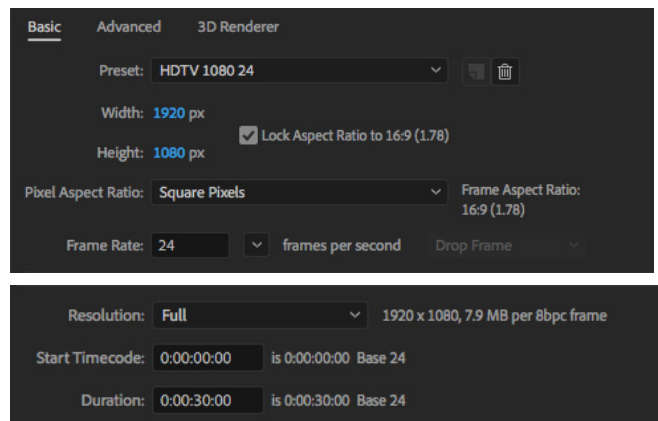
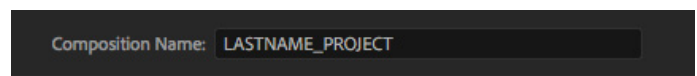
Under composition settings you can name your composition.

This is not how to name your project, only your compositions

After Effects would name your compositions “Comp 1,” “Comp 2,” and so on.

Be careful and check the project settings. Make sure frame rate is at 24.

The Start Timecode should be 0:00:00:00
Duration is how long your timeline will be (here it will be 30 seconds long)



When the settings are correct hit OK

Under composition settings you can name your composition. Remember that this is not how to name your project. After Effects will name your compositions “Comp 1,” “Comp 2,” and so on.

Be careful and check the project settings.

Make sure frame rate is at 24.

The timecode should be 0:00:00:00
