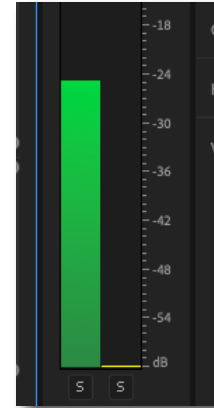


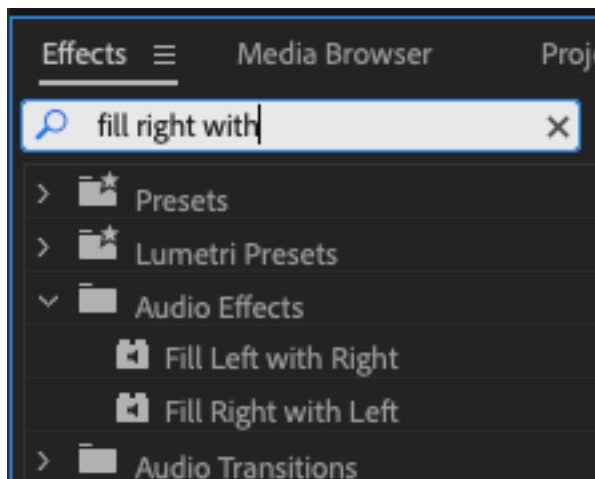
Using the “Fill” audio filter to modify left and right channel audio within a sequence

If you find a audio clip in your sequence that needs to be modified so that the sound is coming from both left and right instead of just one or the other, you can apply a filter to it.

In this case, we have audio on the left but need it also on the right.



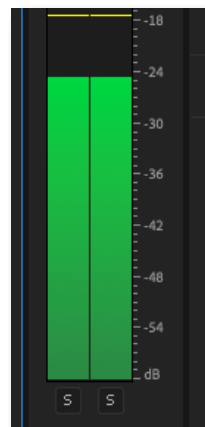
In your project under Effects, search for *Fill Right with Left*.



With the clip you need to modify selected in the sequence, double-click on the filter, and it should apply to the selected clip.

You can also select the filter and drag it over onto the clip in the sequence. If there are more than one clip that you need to affect, you can select them all while dragging the filter and it will be applied to them all at the same time.

That clip will now have been modified to have both left and right active.



Remember, this will affect only the clip you applied the filter to in the sequence- not the original file in the project. To affect the original file, you would need to modify it by following the first example.
