



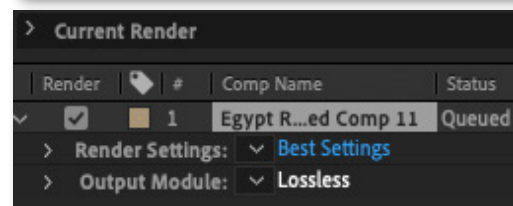
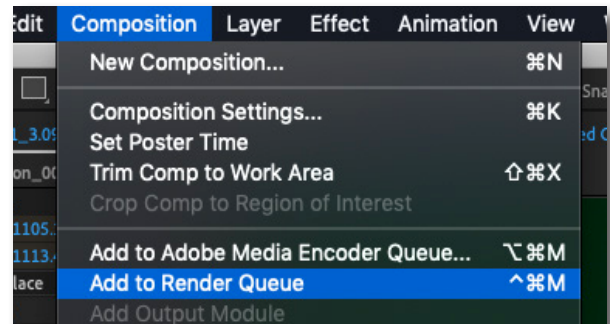
Exporting via the Render Queue in After Effects

When you are ready to export a video file of your composition, you do so via the Render Queue.

From the top menu, select
Composition>Add to Render Queue

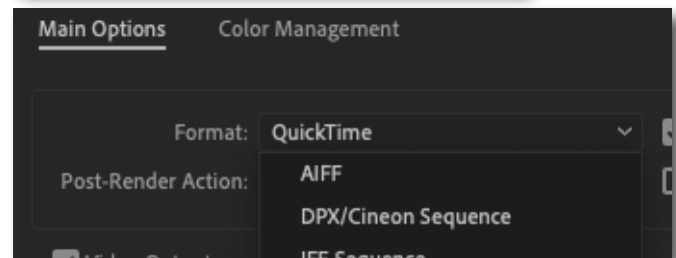
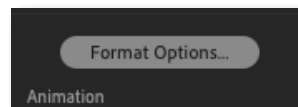
The Render Queue window will become visible in the Timeline pane. We will need to select the format the file will be created in, and the location we will send the newly created file to.

Next to the **Output Module** option, click on the highlighted *Lossless* option

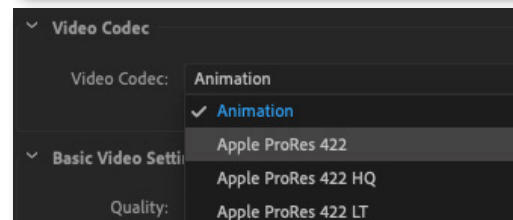


In the **Format** pull-down menu, select Quicktime, and the OK button at the bottom to complete that selection.

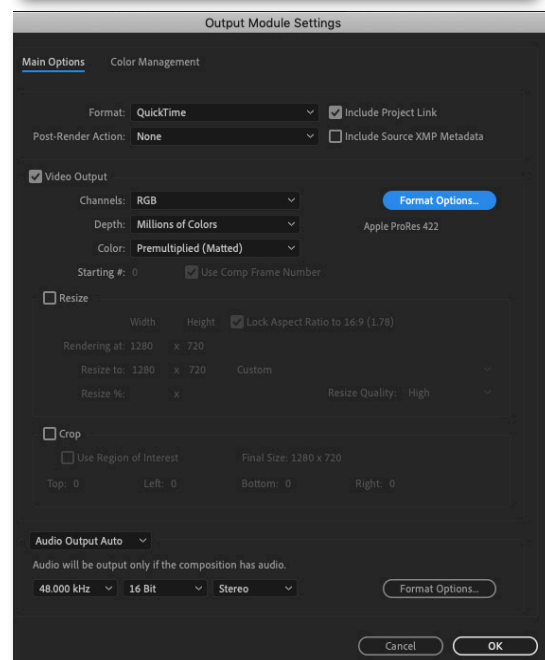
Next, click on the **Format Options** button



From the **Video Codec** pull-down menu, choose Apple ProRes 422



With these video file format settings in place, click the OK button at the bottom of the window.

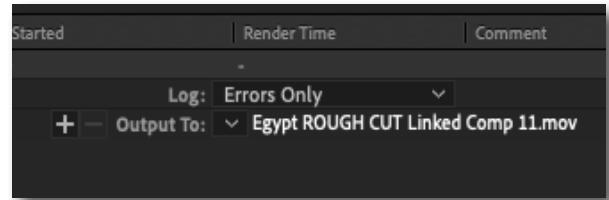




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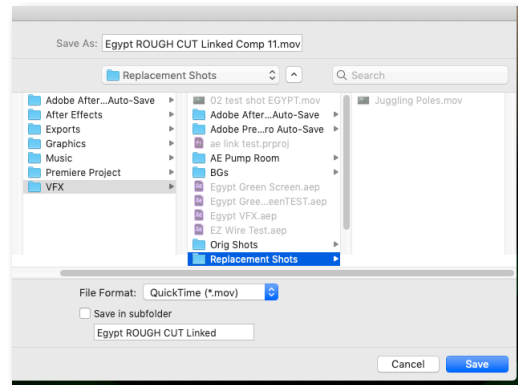
Next we will select where the rendered file will be saved to. Click on the highlighted text to the right of the **Output To:** option



In the window that opens, navigate to the folder you want to save this new file to. You can create a new folder, if need be.

This is also an opportunity to re-name the file that you are exporting (at the top, in the **Save As:** window).

When that is done, click the **Save** button



With that window closed, you can now click on the Render button at the bottom right of the Render Queue window. Your file will 'render out' and the finished file will be available in the location you previously specified.
